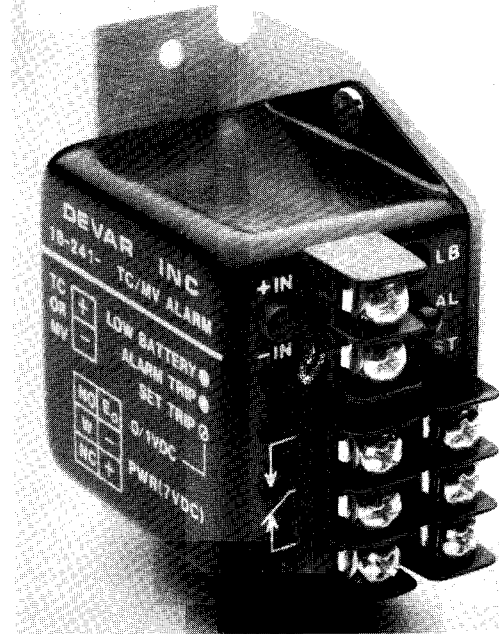

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

When a temperature alarm is needed, with minimal space to mount it, the 18-241 Thermocouple Alarm is the answer!

The Devar 18-241 Thermocouple Alarm Trip provides a compact, low cost, versatile alarm which is suitable for high or low temperature alarm action.

It is ideal for surface or 3" snap track mounting with wiring via standard screw terminals. Cold junction compensation for all ISA thermocouple types is provided and is located at the terminal strip so that ambient temperature changes have minimal effect on the measurement accuracy.

The 18-241 features a 0 to 100% adjustable set point which may be read as a 0 to 1.0 VDC signal at the field wiring terminal block. This unique set point measurement facilitates alarm settings eliminating the need of a T/C calibrator. A simple multi-meter is used to read the set point voltage. An LED lamp provides indication of alarm conditions.

Standard features include thermocouple break, UP or DOWN scale; adjustable deadband from 1.6% to 8% of span; selection of high or low alarm action and RFI protection to meet SAMA specifications PMC 33.1 - 1978 2 abc.

For locations where electrical power is not available, an optional battery pack (option - B) incorporating lithium batteries is offered. These batteries will remain operational for 1 year on standby and 19 days in the alarm condition. A second LED indicator flashes when the battery power level is low.

The unit is supplied with a standard surface mounting bracket that may also be snapped into a 3 in. Snap Track. Other mounting options include DIN Rail mounting (option M31D), NEMA 4x (-NE4) and explosion proof mounting (-M37E).

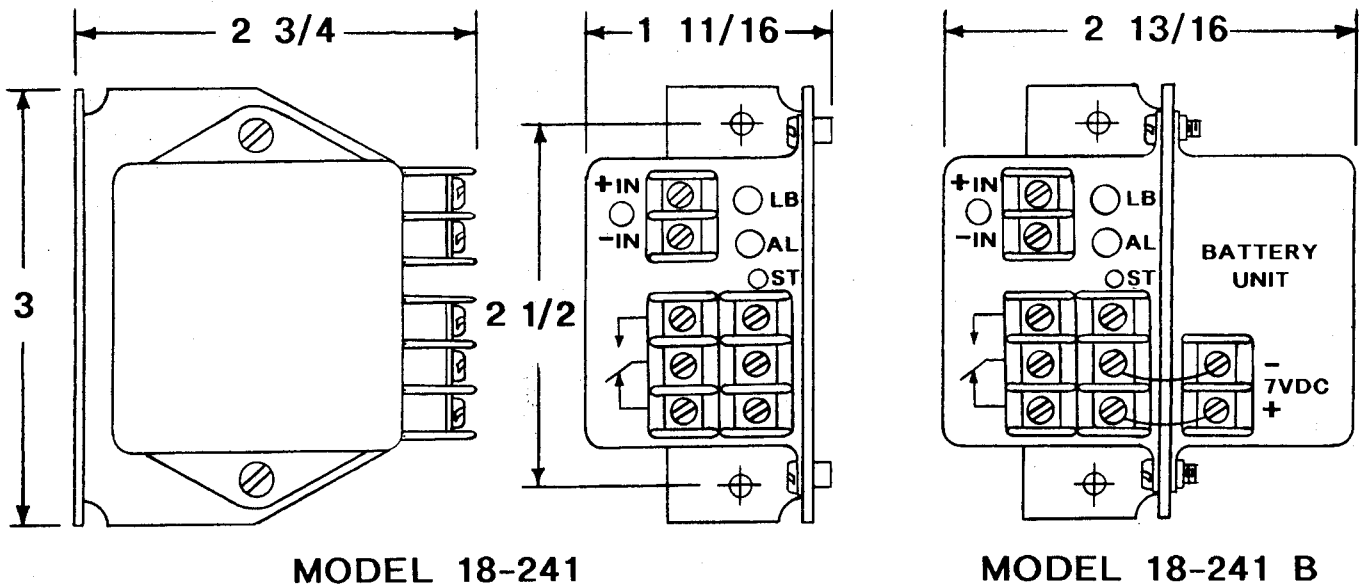
