

Apparently, on installation to an XP system with Service Pack 2 and that contains certain bits of hardware, the system will respond with an error saying that file HHCTRL.ocx has accessed an address normally reserved for some other Microsoft function.

The ReadData program might not run on some systems unless a Microsoft hotfix is installed. The hotfix is named WindowsXP-KB935448-x86-ENU.exe and can be obtained at
